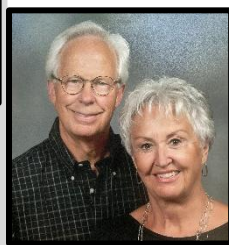

Bill states: "I've been interested in, and creating art, since high school...I paint what interests me, a landscape, a bird, a flower, inspiration is everywhere."

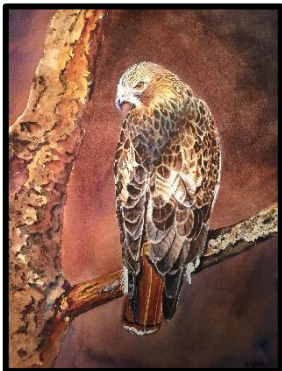
Ginny remarks: "I enjoy drawing birds, animals, flowers and have recently begun people portraits."



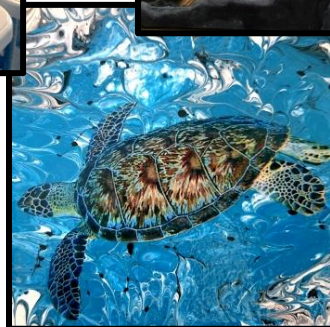
Featured Artist: Gary Wigman
